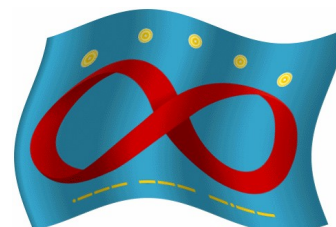
WHEN: July 20, 2011, 1PM - 4PM EST in honor of the 42nd anniversary of the first lunar launch.
