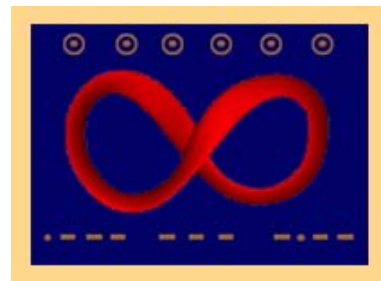

**TERASEM ANNOUNCES LAUNCH OF THE
ONLINE JOURNAL OF GEOETHICAL NANOTECHNOLOGY**

Melbourne Beach, Florida, February 14, 2006 – The Terasem Movement, Inc. (Terasem), announced today the launch of the Online Journal of Geoethical Nanotechnology, a quarterly journal freely available to libraries and the public at <http://www.terasemjournal.org>.

The Online Journal of Geoethical Nanotechnology is the journal covering nanotechnology from multiple diverse perspectives including engineering, physics, chemistry, biology, law, performance art, business, sociology and psychology. This inaugural issue of the Online Journal of Geoethical Nanotechnology strives to be a unique and valuable resource asset for students, researchers and enthusiasts.

The premier issue includes articles by Natasha Vita-More, President of the Extropy Institute; Martine Rothblatt, Ph.D., technology creator; and Baruch (Barry) Blumberg, M.D., Ph.D., President of the American Philosophical Society and winner of the Nobel Prize for Medicine.

"The Online Journal of Geoethical Nanotechnology fills a crucial, unmet need in the rapidly developing field of automated molecular assembly," said Douglas Mulhall, author of *The Calcium Bomb* and *Our Molecular Future*. "This new Journal is an ideal forum for the rapid publication of scholarly articles on the global, ethical implications of atom-sized machinery." Gillian Markowski is the Journal's Content and Web Presentation Editor. Loraine J. Rhodes is its Managing Editor.

In addition to publishing the Journal, Terasem (founded in 2002), also convenes publicly accessible symposia, which include the Annual Workshop on Geoethical Nanotechnology and the Colloquium on the Law of Cyberconscious Persons. Terasem Movement Inc. also conducts demonstration projects, encourages student participation, and issues grants.
